PACD has not had significant COVID-19 related expenses.

Amy and Brenda gave a report on a potential new grant PACD would participate in under DEP, but funded by NFWF. This small technical assistance grant would provide mini-grants for stormwater education and outreach projects to the districts. This concept will be further developed in the near future.
