Contest Rules

- 1. There is no longer a poster size requirement.
- 2. Clearly print your name and information on the entry form and email one per poster entry. Entries should be submitted via e-mail to swehinger@pacd.org with the poster attached as a .jpg or PDF by June 30.
- 3. Theme "Home is Where the Habitat Is" <u>MUST</u> be on your poster.
- 4. Poster must be flat no 3-D objects
- 5. One entry per student.

What Makes a Good Poster?

- Colorful posters are best! Use markers, paint, colored pencils, crayons, charcoal, etc. Avoid thin-lined, light-colored artwork.
- ◊ Painted, hand-drawn, braille, or digital posters accepted.
- Balance a combination of illustrations and words.
- ♦ Text should be large enough to be easily read. Be as neat as you can be.
- Use colors and white space effectively—attract attention!
- Research the theme as a way to brainstorm ideas.
