The Huntingdon County Conservation District is looking for candidates to fill a full-time position as the Watershed Specialist. The position requires both office and field work. Candidates should review the full job description prior to applying.

The Watershed Specialist position serves as a source of technical assistance and public outreach to landowners, community groups, and local schools. Duties include water quality monitoring, grant writing, environmental education, and other conservation and restoration projects. The Watershed Specialist also serves as the coordinator for county recycling and Keep Huntingdon County Beautiful and works with community volunteers to fulfill this program.

Typical hours of employment are 8:30-4:00, with some evening and weekend hours required for events or special programs. RESPONSIBILITIES: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to satisfactorily perform duties within the following programs that include but are not limited to:

 - Demonstration site development and maintenance
 - Grant writing to implement restoration projects
- 2) Environmental education
 - Field trips and programs in local schools
 - Presentations to various community groups
 - One-on-one correspondence with landowners
- 3) Keep Huntingdon County Beautiful and recycling coordination
 - Cleanup event coordination
 - Recycling education
 - Special collection events
- 4) Water quality monitoring
 - pH, alkalinity, and related field testing for abandoned mine drainage

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Bachelor Degree in Natural Sciences, Environmental Resources Management, Environmental Science, or a closely related environmental field
- Experience with basic water quality monitoring and environmental restoration projects

Attendance at annual training is required as part of the program deliverables.
