Did you know there are easy steps you can take to make a difference in your community?

Every day, the state's sixty-six conservation districts work to prevent pollution in Pennsylvania. But we can't do this alone. We need your help. Conservation can start in your yard!

By taking a few simple steps, we can all make a difference:

- Skip spring lawn fertilizer because
 - It can cause pollution; and
 - It is more effective applied in the fall
- If you do use fertilizer
 - Use phosphorus-free fertilizer
 - Only use fertilizer if rain is not expected for 24 hours after application; and
 - Sweep excess fertilizer off pavement to prevent water pollution.

Together, we can conserve our resources. Remember, it's up to all of us to be good stewards of our commonwealth.
