

VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

Resource Conservation Technician

The Juniata County Conservation District is seeking qualified candidates for a Resource Conservation Technician position. This position will work with the District's Dirt, Gravel and Low Volume Road Program; and also, the Chapter 102 (Erosion and Sedimentation Control) and Chapter 92 (NPDES) Programs; as well as assist with other District programs, as needed. The position requires a 40-hour workweek.

The individual chosen for this position is responsible for fulfilling the District's obligations under the Chapter 102 Delegation Agreement with PA Department of Environmental Protection, as well as obligations under the Dirt, Gravel and Low Volume Road Program Contract with PA State Conservation Commission

Duties include, but are not limited to: working with Municipalities in identifying and implementing Dirt, Gravel and Low Volume Road projects; review of Erosion and Sediment Pollution Control (E&S) Plans & NPDES Permit applications; perform inspections of E&S project sites to determine compliance with permits and programs; assist landowners with E&S concerns; respond to E&S complaints; initiate voluntary E&S compliance; understand and interpret pertinent E&S regulations to the local agricultural and nonagricultural communities; assist landowners with DEP General Permit inquiries; maintaining files and preparing progress reports; assisting with other District related programs, education and training activities.

The individual chosen for this position will hold a Bachelor's degree with major course emphasis in Environmental Resource Management, Agriculture, Civil Engineering, or other related area of study or equivalent experience. The individual will be computer literate with Microsoft Office and GIS software, possess a valid driver's license and the ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing, have the ability to work independently and traverse difficult terrain.

Hours of employment are Monday through Friday, 8 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., with some weekend / evening hours required. The successful candidate will be required to complete Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance and the Pennsylvania Criminal Background Check (PATCH).
